CHAIR THOMPSON: Okay. Hey, good morning, everybody. This is Gary Thompson, Chair of the Board of Elections, and with me is Karyn Greenfield, our Board member. That's two out of three, so we do have a quorum and we will proceed with our Special Meeting.

Our agenda for this meeting has been distributed in advance and duly noticed, and I would move that we adopt the agenda as distributed.

MEMBER GREENFIELD: Second.

CHAIR THOMPSON: All right. I guess, for formality, all in favor?

MEMBER GREENFIELD: All in favor.

CHAIR THOMPSON: Okay, we have an agenda, it's pretty straightforward. We are here to do just one quick thing, which is to certify the results of a special recall election of Ms.

Amber Gove, Advisory Neighborhood Commissioner for Single Member District 6A04, on Capitol Hill.

With that, I will turn it over to --1 2 I don't know, General Counsel Stroud? MS. STROUD: Actually, Executive 3 4 Director Evans. 5 CHAIR THOMPSON: Oh, okay. Go ahead. MS. EVANS: Yes, thank you, and good 6 7 morning. As you mentioned, the only item of 8 business is certification of the October 23rd 9 special recall election for 6A04. Four-hundred-10 and-sixty-seven votes were cast. There were 15 11 special ballots. Fourteen special or provisional 12 ballots were accepted, one special ballot was 13 rejected. 14 The results, we had 109 votes in favor of the recall of Amber Gove, ANC Commissioner 15 16 6A04, 357 votes against the recall of Amber Gove, 17 ANC Commissioner 6A04. The petition to recall 18 Amber Gove, ANC Commissioner 6A04, failed. 19 Mr. Chair, I ask for a vote to certify 20 the October 23rd special recall election results 21 as presented. 22 CHAIR THOMPSON: Thank you so much.

1 I so move that we certify those results.

MEMBER GREENFIELD: I second it.

CHAIR THOMPSON: All right. All in

favor?

MEMBER GREENFIELD: Aye.

CHAIR THOMPSON: The motion passes.

And I just want to say thank you to the voters of Single Member District 6A04. This is a rare bird, a recall election at the ANC level. They don't happen too often. And I'm glad that the BOE was able to administer the election with two locations to vote last Sunday. There was a pretty good turnout, from what it sounds like, and I really thank the voters for taking the time to come out and participate.

And I understand that the DC Council's legislation, which affects a lot of -- most recent legislation, which affects a lot of things about voting, provides that in future recall elections, even at the ANC level, there will be mailed ballots in the future. So if there's another one of these in the next cycle, or

whenever, next year, there'll be that added element of voter participation.

So it all went off this time around, went very well, thanks to voter participation especially. And if called upon to do this again, we'll add the element of mailed ballots and make sure everybody gets a chance for their voice to be heard. Just a comment.

MS. EVANS: Thank you.

CHAIR THOMPSON: As you know, I'm sensitive to ANC issues because I was on the ANC for eight years. So, I don't think we ever had a recall election when I was on our ANC, but I heard about them in other ANCs.

Well, with that, I would move that we adjourn.

MEMBER GREENFIELD: I second it.

CHAIR THOMPSON: All right. We are so adjourned. And thank you, four our three attendees. Thank you to everybody at the BOE, I didn't say that. Thank you to everybody at the BOE who went out there on a Sunday to work those
