**DCBOE Confirms Start Date for Pre-Election Testing of Voter Equipment
for December 4 Special Election**

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) will conduct the process known as “Logic and Accuracy Testing” of voting equipment in preparation for the December 4, 2018 Special Election,

This process takes place prior to each election to verify that all voting equipment used will accurately count the votes cast in all contests. Testing is tentatively scheduled to begin on Friday, November 16, 2018 at 10am and will conclude at such time as the testing is complete. Testing will occur at 3535 V St NE.
