DCBOE Post-Election Information

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) would like to remind any voter who cast a challenged or special ballot in the November 6 General Election that they can learn the Board’s preliminary decision whether to count or reject their ballot by visiting the Board’s website [here](#). Alternatively, they may also call 1-866-DCVOTES to receive the same information by phone.

Furthermore, the Board has conducted its random selection of precincts, voter-verifiable records tabulated centrally, and contests for the manual audit. The results of this random selection revealed that the following contests will be recounted:
