**DCBOE to Select Precincts and Contests for Post-Election
Audit on Thursday, November 19**

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) is today announcing that the selection of precincts and contests for unofficial results to be audited from the November 3, 2020 General Election will take place on Thursday, November 19, at 12pm.

In light of the continuing public health crisis, the selection will take place remotely. Members of the public can access the meeting by using the following information:

The Board completes an audit before certifying the outcome of the election. Unofficial results to be audited will include ballots cast during Early Voting, Election Day as well as mail-in and special ballots. The audit will begin on Monday, November 23, 2020 at 8am and will continue until completed.

The random selection of precincts and contests will be conducted by drawing slips of paper from a hat. At least one precinct from each ward and at least one District-wide as well as two ward-wide contests are required to be selected at random. In addition, the Executive Director will select another contest to be audited.

The District of Columbia Board of Elections is an independent agency of the District of Columbia Government responsible for the administration of elections, ballot access, and voter registration.
