DCBOE to Conduct its Biennial Canvass of Registered Voters

WASHINGTON, D.C., The D.C. Board of Elections (DCBOE) would like to announce that the biennial canvass of registered voters will begin at the end of this month.

This process will involve mailing a nonforwardable postcard to the address listed in the Board's records to each voter who did not vote in the November 6, 2018 General Election. Depending on the information received from that mailing, the Board will notify any affected voter of next steps.

The purpose of the canvass is to maintain a voter roll that is made up of current District residents only, and that reflects each voter's current residence address.

Any voter who receives a postcard is encouraged to communicate with the Board as soon as possible to keep their registration information current.

The District of Columbia Board of Elections is an independent agency of the District of Columbia Government responsible for the administration of elections, ballot access, and voter registration.
