DCBOE to Conduct Pre-Election Testing of Voting Equipment

WASHINGTON, DC – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) will conduct the process known as “Logic and Accuracy Testing” of voting equipment in preparation for the November 8, 2022 General Election.

This process takes place prior to each election to verify that all voting equipment used will accurately count the votes cast in all contests.

Testing will begin on Monday, September 19, at 10 am and will conclude at such time as the testing is complete. Testing will occur at 3535 V St NE.
