**DCBOE Reminds Military and Overseas Voters to Prepare
for Ward 2 Special Election**

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) wants to remind military and overseas civilian voters to prepare for the June 16, 2020 Ward 2 Special Election to ensure their ability to participate in the democratic process. Mail-in (absentee) ballot requests must be received by **June 13, 2020**. All signed and completed mail-in (absentee) ballots must be RECEIVED by June 26, 2020 and must be postmarked on or before Election Day (June 16). Any e-mailed or faxed absentee ballots must be received by 8 p.m. on Election Day.
