**Early Voting Begins on Monday, October 22**

**WASHINGTON, D.C.** - The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) would like to remind District residents that Early Voting for the November 6 General Election begins on October 22 at One Judiciary Square (OJS).

From 8:30 am until 7 pm, every day from October 22 to November 2 (including the weekend), voters can cast their ballots at OJS regardless of their address. OJS will be the **only** Early Voting Center that will have paper ballots.

Beginning on October 26, Satellite Early Voting Centers will open throughout the District. The complete list of Early Voting Centers is available online at <https://earlyvoting.dcboe.org/> Please note that all Satellite Early Voting Centers will have **touchscreen ballots only**.
