DCBOE is Recruiting Poll Workers for the 2020 Elections!

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Here at the District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE), preparations are beginning for the 2020 Primary and General Elections. The Board is recruiting talented District residents interested in serving their city!

To serve as a Poll Worker, you must:

- Be either:
 - a registered voter (*in order to serve as a Precinct Captain, you must be a registered voter) or;
 - a District resident who is at least 16 years of age and a student or graduate of a public or private secondary school or an institution of higher education*;
- Attend and pass a training class prior to the election;
- Be able to read, write, and speak English;
- Be able to perform basic math;
- Have a strong understanding of, and commitment to, nonpartisanship; and
- Have the ability to communicate in a friendly and effective manner with voters.
