# Important Information

As a registered voter in the District of Columbia, you may vote by mail or in person.

## 1) VOTE BY MAIL

Every registered voter will be mailed a ballot for the November 3 General Election.

Voted ballots that are transmitted electronically, deposited at Mail Ballot Drop Boxes, or deposited at Vote Centers, must be received by 8:00 pm on November 3.

All mailed ballots must be postmarked by Tuesday, November 3, and received by the 10th day after the election.

### Military and Overseas Voters

Additional services are available to military and overseas voters (members of the uniformed services, their spouses or dependents, and overseas civilian voters). U.S. citizens who were born overseas have the opportunity to vote from the same address where their parents most recently lived in the District of Columbia.

Military and overseas voters can use the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA), which serves as a combined voter registration and absentee ballot request document. The FPCA is available for download from the Department of Defense's Federal Voting Assistance Program (FVAP) site at <https://www.fvap.gov/district-of-columbia>. You may email your completed FPCA to [uocava@dcboe.org](mailto:uocava@dcboe.org). The Board must receive your request for a military/overseas absentee ballot no later than 4:45 pm on Saturday, October 31, 2020.

You can receive and return your absentee (mail-in) ballot by mail, fax, or email. If it is getting close to Election Day and you have not received your mail ballot, you can use the Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot (FWAB) as an emergency, backup ballot. FVAP provides fillable FWABs and provides assistance in using FWABs at <https://www.fvap.gov/district-of-columbia>.

### Registered Incarcerated Voters

DC registered voters at the Central Detention Facility (CDF), the Correctional Treatment Facility (CTF), and the Federal Bureau of Prisons (BOP), will be mailed a ballot for the November 3 General Election.

## 2) VOTE IN PERSON AT A VOTE CENTER

You can cast your ballot at any Vote Center, regardless of your residential address. Voted mail ballots may also be deposited at any Vote Center.

## Key Dates

### **MONDAY, October 5, 2020 — TUESDAY, November 3, 2020**

- Mail Ballot Drop Boxes will be open until 8:00 pm on November 3.

### **TUESDAY, October 13, 2020**

- Deadline for the receipt of voter registration applications submitted by mail or online.

### **TUESDAY, October 27, 2020 — MONDAY, November 2, 2020**

- Election Week voting (early voting)
- 32 Vote Centers will be open from 8:30 am – 7:00 pm.

### **SATURDAY, October 31, 2020**

- Last day the Board will accept military and overseas voter absentee (mail-in) ballot requests.
- Requests must be received by 4:45 pm.

### **TUESDAY, November 3, 2020: GENERAL ELECTION DAY — LAST DAY TO VOTE!**

- 95 Vote Centers will be open from 7:00 am – 8:00 pm.
- As long as you are in line by 8:00 pm, you will be able to vote.
- All absentee (mail-in) ballots must be postmarked by November 3 and received at the Board by November 13, 2020 in order to be counted.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **How do I register or update my voter registration information?**

Check your voter registration and update any information at <https://dcboe.org/Voters/Register-To-Vote/Register-to-Vote>. You may register to vote online, by email, or mail by the October 13 deadline, or same-day register at any Vote Center from October 27–November 3 with proof of residence.

### **What if I do not receive my mail ballot?**

You may contact the Board by October 19 at (202)727-2525, if you do not receive your ballot. **If you do not receive your ballot by October 21, 2020, please plan to vote in person.**

### **When is the best time to vote?**

Use “The Queue,” available at [www.dcboe.org](http://www.dcboe.org), to see real-time wait times at Early Vote Centers.

### **When will election results be released?**

The first set of unofficial election results will be released on November 3. These results will include all mail ballots processed by November 3, and ballots cast in-person at Vote Centers. The results will be continuously released as ballots (postmarked by November 3) are received through November 13. Official election results will not be released until after all mail and valid special ballots have been processed and tabulated, a post-election audit has been conducted, and the Board has certified the results of the election.

## Prohibited Activity

### In the District of Columbia, it is against the law to:

- make false statements about one's eligibility to register, vote, or hold elective office;
- interfere with a person who is attempting to register or vote;
- bribe or intimidate any voter;
- vote more than once in an election;
- steal or hide votes cast in an election, or obtain, cast, or count false or fake ballots;
- pay, offer to pay, or accept anything of value for registering or voting; or
- obtain or submit false or fake voter registration applications.

Any person found guilty of engaging in illegal activities may be fined up to \$10,000, imprisoned up to five (5) years, or both.

## Accessible Voting

The Board of Elections is committed to ensuring that every voter has equal access to the voting process. The Board's Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)/Language Access Coordinator is responsible for coordinating the Board's efforts to increase access and encourage participation by voters with disabilities, senior citizens, and voters with limited English proficiency by providing the following services:

- Voter Assistance Clerks and ADA Compliance Assistants are available to assist with the voting process. In addition, voters may receive assistance with the voting process from anyone they choose (including persons who accompany them to the voting location), other than poll watchers, election observers, their employer or their employer's agent, or an officer or agent of their union. Any individual who assists a voter must complete the List of Assisted Voters Form at the Vote Center.
- Individuals who provide assistance to voters must not try to influence the voter's vote, mark the voter's ballot in a way other than the way the voter requested, or tell anyone how the voter voted.
- Vote Centers will be equipped with in-person and/or video interpreting technology. Voters will have access to over 40 languages, including American Sign Language, language access kits (translated voting information), bilingual election workers, and multilanguage signs/posters.
- The Board operates an Election Day hotline dedicated to assisting voters who encounter accessibility and language access issues.

## Voter Rights

### As a voter in the District of Columbia, it is your right to:

- register and vote free from discrimination, intimidation, threat, or coercion;
- learn whether your voter registration application has been accepted or rejected;
- receive instructions from election officials on how to cast your ballot;
- inspect a sample ballot and other voting information posted in the polling place;
- bring voter information materials into the voting booth;
- vote privately and independently;
- vote in an accessible polling place with accessible voting equipment;
- receive language access services if you are a person with limited English proficiency;
- ask for and receive assistance with voting from anyone you choose (other than a poll watcher, an election observer, your employer, or an officer from your union), including an election worker, if you have a disability, are visually impaired, or cannot read or write;
- have a ballot brought to your vehicle instead of entering the polling place if you are 65 years of age or older, or if you have a disability;
- bring resources inside the polling place that will help you manage your disability, including wheelchairs, canes, walkers, service animals, etc.;
- vote a special (provisional) ballot if your eligibility to vote is in question;
- learn whether your special (provisional) ballot was counted and, if not, why not;
- receive up to two (2) replacement ballots if you make a mistake before casting your ballot; and
- vote if you are in line at 8 pm.

## Voter Responsibilities

### As a voter in the District of Columbia, it is your responsibility to:

- treat election workers with courtesy and follow their instructions;
- keep your voter registration information (name, address, party affiliation status) up-to-date with the Board of Elections;
- familiarize yourself with the candidates and measures on the ballot;
- know your polling place location and hours of operation;
- bring the proper documentation with you to the polling place if you are required to show proof of residence;
- make sure you have received the correct ballot before you vote;
- familiarize yourself with the operation of the voting equipment at your polling place;
- respect the privacy of other voters; and
- report any problems or violations of elections laws to the Site Coordinator.
