Board of Elections to Select Precincts for Post-Election Audit

WASHINGTON, DC – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) today announces that the random selection of precincts and contests for unofficial results to be audited from the April 1 Primary Election will take place on Friday, April 11 at 12:00 p.m.

DCBOE traditionally completes an audit before certifying the outcome of the election. Unofficial results to be audited will include ballots cast on Primary Day, in addition to absentee and special ballots that will be counted on Friday as well.

The random selection must include at least one precinct from each ward, at least one District-wide contest, and at least two ward contests. The Executive Director may, at his discretion, select another contest for audit.

The selection of precincts and contests will be held in the DCBOE hearing room, located at One Judiciary Square, 441 4th St NW, Room 280 North. The audit will take place on the 11th floor of the Conference Center at One Judiciary Square. Both events are open to the public.

The District of Columbia Board of Elections is an independent agency of the District of Columbia Government responsible for the administration of elections, ballot access, and voter registration.
