**Board of Elections Announces Final Count  
of Absentee and Special Ballots**

*Post-Election Audit to Occur on Monday, April 14 at 10 a.m.*

WASHINGTON, DC – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) announces the final unofficial tabulation of absentee and special ballots ended today, April 11, 2014.

Pursuant to regulation, DCBOE accepted absentee ballots postmarked by Primary Day, April 1, 2014 and received by 5 p.m. on April 11. These ballots, along with special ballots determined to be valid, were tabulated and posted at <http://bit.ly/1hy3Oln>. DCBOE also reminds voters that unofficial results for the Primary Election will be audited on Monday, April 14 at 10 a.m. The audit, which is open to the public at DCBOE headquarters, will feature the following precincts and contests, which were selected at random:

- **Ward 1 – Precinct 137**
- **Ward 2 – Precinct 3**
- **Ward 3 – Precinct 28**
- **Ward 4 – Precinct 63**
- **Ward 5 – Precinct 75**
- **Ward 6 – Precinct 130**
- **Ward 7 – Precinct 80**
- **Ward 8 – Precinct 112**
- **Citywide Contest – Mayor**
- **Ward Contests – Wards 5 and 6 Members of the Council**

A report of the audit results will be published at the DCBOE website prior to certification. The Board will certify the official election results at its regular meeting on April 23, 2014.
