**Board Reminds Military and Overseas Voters to Plan for Ward 8 State
Board of Education Special Election**

Registration-by-mail deadline is June 16, 2014

WASHINGTON, DC — The Board of Elections today reminds military and overseas civilian voters to plan ahead to ensure their ability to participate in the Ward 8 State Board of Education Special Election on July 15, 2014.

Under District law, all voters who wish to register by mail must postmark their applications by Monday, June 16, 2014. All voters are encouraged to verify their registration status prior to the registration-by-mail deadline.

Absentee ballot requests must be received by Tuesday, July 8, 2014. Completed absentee ballots must be postmarked by Election Day, July 15, 2014, and received by the Board of Elections by Friday, July 25, 2014. Any e-mailed absentee ballots must be received by Election Day.

Pursuant to the Comprehensive Military and Overseas Voters Accommodation Amendment Act of 2011 (D.C. Law 19-137), the Board has expanded assistance to ensure military and overseas citizens are able to register to vote, request an absentee ballot, and cast a ballot.
