Results of Post-Election Audit for the April 1, 2014 Primary Election

WASHINGTON, DC – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) announces the results of the post-election audit that was conducted on Monday, April 14, 2014. In accordance with District regulations, DCBOE randomly selected one precinct per ward, one District-wide contest, and two ward contests for the audit. The precincts and contests that were selected, and the results of the audit, are listed below:

The hand count of paper ballots resulted in a small discrepancy between the votes recorded on the optical scanner and the votes identified by visual inspection. Differences

between the hand count and the machine count are commonly the result of either additional or incomplete marks made by a voter on the ballot, or from counting errors on the part of the audit teams.

No further action is required by DCBOE as all contests fell within the 0.025 percent margin of error. The official results of the April 1, 2014 Primary Election will be certified during the Board's public meeting on April 23, 2014 at 10:30 a.m.
