**Board to Conduct Pre-Election Testing of Voter Equipment for
Ward 8 State Board of Education Special Election**

WASHINGTON, DC – Beginning June 2, 2014 at 9:00am, the District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) will conduct pre-election testing of voting equipment to be used in the July 15 Ward 8 State Board of Education Special Election.

The process, known as “logic and accuracy testing,” takes place prior to each election to verify that all equipment is in working order, votes are properly recorded, and all hardware and software are correctly configured for the specific election.

All stages of the testing process are open to the public. Those interested in observing should contact DCBOE at (202) 727-2511.

The District of Columbia Board of Elections is an independent agency of the District of Columbia Government responsible for the administration of elections, ballot access, and voter registration.
