A Message to Our Voters

Dear Voters,

The DCBOE strives for transparency in all we do, as clean, fair, and transparent elections are the cornerstone of our responsibility to the residents of the District of Columbia. To that end:

- 1) We will make public the April Primary After-Action Report by October 3, 2014.
- 2) Prior to Election Night, we will publish a step-by-step projected timeline of reporting results.
- 3) Shutting down the electronic voting machines and the tabulation of results takes the same amount of time whether 1 person or 1,000 people voted. Voter turnout does not affect tabulation time.
- 4) After the polls close at 8:00pm, it may take a minimum of three (3) hours to tabulate results. We anticipate the majority of unofficial election results will be available between 11:00pm and 12:00midnight.
- 5) All hands will be on deck to monitor the technology and catch any issues that may arise.
- 6) We will make sure pencils and pens (remember, you can use either a pen or a pencil) are available at the polls on Election Day!

We care. We want to have your faith and trust. We want you to have a good voting experience. Come see us on November 4th.
