*Early Voting to Begin in the District of Columbia*

**Washington, D.C.** – With only 19 days left until the District of Columbia’s General Election, the Board of Elections is making all of the necessary preparations to accommodate the voting public. Among them is Early Voting which begins at One Judiciary Square on Monday, October 20<sup>th</sup> and runs through Saturday, November 1<sup>st</sup>.

Early Voting hours are Monday through Saturday from 8:30a.m. to 7:00p.m. The Centers are closed on Sunday. During Early Voting, District voters may cast their ballot at any Early Voting location. However, on November 4<sup>th</sup> (Election Day) you must vote at your assigned precinct.
