D.C. Board of Elections Counts Over 20,000 Special and Absentee General Election Ballots

WASHINGTON, D.C. – More than 20,000 special ballots were cast in the November 4, 2014 General Election. As of November 13, 2014, DCBOE has processed more than 5,400 of these special ballots, in addition to the approximately 6,000 absentee ballots received thus far. DCBOE will continue to work diligently to process the remaining special ballots, and any absentee ballots that are postmarked on or before Election Day and received by the close of business today.

“All permanent staff, with the help of our dedicated volunteers, is working hard, including evenings and weekends, to ensure each ballot is processed and counted,” said Clifford Tatum, DCBOE Executive Director. “Because every vote is important, we want to make sure that every vote is counted.”
