***BOE Announces Final Count of Absentee & Special Ballots***  
*Post-Election Audit, Scheduled for May 11th*

**WASHINGTON, D.C.** – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) has completed the unofficial tabulation of all absentee and special ballots from the April 28, 2015 Special Election. All absentee and special ballots were uploaded into the final unofficial count today at 4:45pm. In Ward 4, Brandon Todd is the unofficial winner garnering 4,584 votes, while in Ward 8, LaRuby May is the unofficial winner garnering 1,955 votes.

Pursuant to regulation, DCBOE accepted absentee ballots postmarked by the day of the Special Election, April 28, 2015, and received by 4:45pm today, May 8, 2015.

Today the DCBOE also held the lottery for the random drawing of the precincts that will be manually audited. The precincts selected were:

- Ward 4 - 55 and 65
- Ward 8 - 118 and 122

The audit will be conducted on Monday, May 11, 2015 at 10:00am in Room 1114 at 441 4<sup>th</sup> Street NW.

DCBOE traditionally completes an audit before certifying the outcome of the election. The certification of the April 28, 2015 Special Election will be held on Thursday, May 14, 2015.
