BOE Announces Availability of Nominating Petitions

WASHINGTON, DC – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) announces that nominating petitions will become available for pick up on Friday morning, January 22, 2016.

In accordance with Mayor Bowser’s decision to close District government offices at noon on Friday, January 22, 2016, the Board of Elections urges everyone to exercise caution and plan for safety when picking up nominating petitions.

Petitions may be obtained at DCBOE offices during regular office hours throughout the entire petition period, until March 16, 2016, the last day to submit nominating petitions to the DCBOE.

The District of Columbia Board of Elections is an independent agency of the District government responsible for the administration of elections, ballot access and voter registration.
