DCBOE Announces Receipt of New Voting Equipment

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) has accepted delivery of new voting equipment. The agency has leased new DS200 tabulators, ExpressVote ballot marking devices, and a DS850 high speed tabulator from Elections Systems & Software (ES&S). This equipment delivery fully replaces the voting machines used in past elections.

The ExpressVote ballot marking devices are ADA accessible, and provide accommodation for individuals with disabilities via a variety of assistive mechanisms. DCBOE is proud to offer these state of the art devices as part of our ADA accessibility program.

Currently, DCBOE, in partnership with ES&S, is rigorously testing every unit as well as creating operating manuals for poll workers. Poll worker training on the new equipment will commence soon. The new equipment will be used in both the Primary and General Elections.

The District of Columbia Board of Elections is an independent agency of the District government responsible for the administration of elections, ballot access and voter registration.
