DCBOE to Conduct Pre-Election Testing of Voter Equipment

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) announces Logic and Accuracy (L&A) Testing of voting equipment will begin on Saturday, September 24, 2016 at 10am, at 3535 V St NE.

Logic and Accuracy Testing takes place prior to each election to verify that all equipment properly tabulates votes. DCBOE staff will inspect all DS200 optical scanners to ensure they are in optimal condition. The public is invited to observe the process.

The District of Columbia Board of Elections is an independent agency of the District of Columbia Government responsible for the administration of elections, ballot access, and voter registration.
