DCBOE joins nationwide effort to register voters on September 27

Washington, D.C. — The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) announces its participation in National Voter Registration Day (NVRD) on Tuesday, September 27.

Designated in 2012 as the fourth Tuesday in September by the National Association of Secretaries of State, NVRD is designed to create an annual moment when the entire nation encourages Americans to exercise their most basic right—the right to vote.
