DC Board of Elections Marks National Voter Registration Day with Citywide Outreach

Washington, D.C. – Today, the District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) marked National Voter Registration Day (NVRD) with a series of outreach activities and events across the city. NVRD activities were held in jurisdictions in all 50 states and the District of Columbia to engage and encourage voters to make their voices heard for the November 8th, 2016 general election.

“We’re excited and working hard today to get ALL eligible DC voters registered - we’ll even help you find out if you’re already registered and that your voting information is up to date,” said Alice P. Miller, DCBOE Executive Director, who met with first and longtime voters and demonstrated the District’s new voting machines during the NVRD festivities. “Registration is the first step to get as many people as possible to the polls on Election Day, November 8th.”

October 11th is the last day for eligible DC residents to register online, through the mobile app, or at DCBOE Headquarters at One Judiciary Square. However, DCBOE allows same day registration on Election Day as part of its “no excuses” initiative to provide a number of flexible options for DC voters to register and vote.

DCBOE staff spent NVRD registering voters, updating voter registrations, and providing information about the upcoming November 8, 2016 General Election at DCBOE Headquarters at One Judiciary Square and the Carlos Rosario International Career Center. This past weekend, DCBOE also joined its partners at several church and community NVRD events around the District to make sure every eligible voter is registered and ready to cast their ballot in just a few weeks.
