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DCBOE to Begin Pre-Election Testing of Voting Equipment on September 14

WASHINGTON, DC – On Monday, September 14, 2026, the District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) will begin the “Logic and Accuracy Testing” of voting equipment in preparation for the November 3, 2026 General Election.

Testing will begin at 10:00 am ET and will conclude when the testing process is complete. Testing will occur at 3535 V Street NE. Additional details about the testing schedule are available upon request.

This process takes place prior to each election to verify that all voting equipment used will accurately count the votes cast in all contests. **Photography in restricted areas will not be allowed during this process.**
