Early Voting Begins Sunday, May 26 in the District of Columbia

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The District of Columbia Board of Elections (DCBOE) wants to remind voters that Early Voting for the June 4, 2024 Primary Election is open from Sunday, May 26, to Sunday, June 2, 2024.

25 Early Vote Centers will be open daily from 8:30 am to 7:00 pm, but will be closed for Memorial Day on Monday, May 27, 2024. Wait times and locations for Early Vote Centers can be found at <https://earlyvoting.dcboe.org/>.

Voters may vote at any of the 25 Early Vote Centers, regardless of their residential address.

Same-day voter registration is available at all Vote Centers with proof of residence, like an ID or utility bill. A list of acceptable proofs of residence can be found here: www.dcboe.org/registertovote.

As a reminder, DCBOE will operate 75 Vote Centers on Primary Election Day, June 4, 2024. Election Day Vote Centers will include all Early Vote Centers.
