ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA—To serve as an **Election Worker**, you must be a District of Columbia resident who is at least 16 years of age and who either attends or has graduated from a public or private secondary school or an institution of higher education.* Election Workers are required to have a valid email address and cell phone number.

To serve as a **Site Coordinator**, you must be a registered voter.*

SELECTION PROCESS—Election Workers are selected as positions become available at Vote Centers throughout the District of Columbia. If selected, you will be contacted by our staff a few months prior to the election. Not all applicants are selected to serve, and an Election Worker is not assured an assignment at the Voter Center(s) nearest to their home.

WORK REQUIREMENTS—Election Workers must:

- Complete a four hour in-person training prior to **EACH** election for which they serve.
- Report to their assigned Vote Center to setup on the Monday before an election. **\$35** is deducted from the **stipend** for failing to report to the Vote Center setup.
- Work at assigned Vote Centers. On Election Day, Election Workers work from 6 a.m. until released by the Site Coordinator (approximately 10:30 p.m.)
